Safety in Schools delivers online, industry-recognized workplace safety training courses to high school students at participating schools, at NO cost to students or schools, along with presentations by survivors of workplace injuries.

The goal of Safety in Schools is to prepare every young person entering the workforce with the knowledge they need to recognize hazards and mitigate risks, regardless of career path or industry.
